And some are skittish and spend a lot of time outside, or will run outside when you come into the room. Salty craves attention but is just a little bit shy. As soon as you sit on the couch you'll find several cats jumping up there with you. After you're thoroughly covered in cats, if Salty is in the room you'll see him come over and stand there, looking wistfully up at you. Sometimes you can persuade him to jump up, but usually not.

You'll need to pick him up - he'll be happy to let you - and put him in your lap. While you're noticing how incredibly soft his fur is, he'll be settling into heaven for as long as you'll hold him.
